### **Student Resource Scheme Information:**

The Student Resource Scheme at Humpybong State School enables your child to have access to:

**Preps – Full Participation is \$160 or \$150 if paid before 28 February** - for Technology, Mathematics & Reading Eggs online, art, craft, photocopying, class supplies, booklist 2017 and a Humpybong SS library bag. This equates to \$4 per week per child.

(No other supplies are required to be purchased by parents participating in the Prep Full Participation of the Student Resource Scheme)

**Yrs 1 – 6 2017 – Full Participation is \$80 or \$75 if paid before 28 February** - for Technology, Mathematics & Reading Eggs online, art, craft and photocopying. This equates to \$2 per week per child.

**Family Cap is set at \$200 (Yr 1-6 only – no prep)      Family Cap is set at \$250 (Prep+Yr 1-6)**

(A booklist of requirements is provided to parents to purchase as a separate requirement to the Student Resource Scheme for Yrs 1-6)

There are a number of options available to families when paying the Student Resource Scheme.

- Option 1: One off full payment – if paid by 28 February will receive the associated discount
- Option 2: Payment plan – forms are available at the school office, eg. \$40 per term
- Option 3: Centrepay deductions:
  - To start Centrepay deductions you will need the following information:
    - Your centrelink Customer Reference Number (CRN)
    - Name of organisation to pay: Humpybong State School
    - Address and phone number: Ernest Street Margate Beach Q 4019 Ph: 3385 1666
    - Centrelink Reference Number of Humpybong State School: 555 108 233B
    - Your account number and/or billing number if you have one (for instance your electricity account/bill number)
    - The amount you want deducted from your Centrelink payments each fortnight
    - The Centrelink payment from which you want the deductions to be paid
    - The payday that you want the deductions to start on.

Centrelink will then send you a letter confirming the details of your deductions and will then commence paying the deductions to the school on the same day that you receive your Centrelink payments. Centrelink will also send the school a report with the details of your deductions so that we can reconcile your account. - Option 4: (Prep) Parent pays school for Technology, Art, Craft, Reading Eggs and Mathematics registration of \$80 and is provided with a booklist which must be provided to the class teacher on the first day of the school year.

As the Student Resource Scheme is directly related to the curriculum and educational needs of your child it is the first priority for payment. The Student Resource Scheme must be up to date in payment prior to your child's participation in any other extra-curricular events (such as interschool sport, swimming, excursions, incursions, camps).
