**\$397,411\***

## This funding will be used to

- Meet the target of 95% in Year 3 and Year 5 of students achieving above NAPLAN National Minimum Standards (NMS) in Reading and Numeracy.
- Meet the target of 45% of Year 3 students achieving in NAPLAN Upper Two Bands (U2B) for Reading and 35% for Numeracy.
- Meet the target of 90% of Prep students exiting at PM Reading Level 7 or above and writing short meaningful sentences.
- Improve teacher pedagogical practices focussed in Reading, Writing and Problem Solving (eg. Computational Thinking).

## Our initiatives include

- Providing deep understanding of the Australian Curriculum and pedagogical coaching for all teachers with dedicated specialised support from the Head of Curriculum, Numeracy Coach, Learning Leaders, Beginning Teacher Mentor, Behaviour Advisory Coach and Digital Technologies Coach.
- Implementing a whole school approach to provide a continuum of literacy/numeracy support with personalised teaching and intervention that meets the needs of all students.
- Continuing to provide teacher skilling in Speech, Sound, Pics (SSP) phonics program for the early years.
- Continuing to implement short, medium and long term goals in a 'cycle of review' that provides for analysis of data to ensure targeted, specific and immediate intervention strategies are in place.
