This funding will be used to

- Meet the target of 85% in Year 3 and 80% in Year 5 of students achieving above NAPLAN National Minimum Standards (NMS) in Reading.
- Meet the target of 80% in Year 3 and 80% in Year 5 of students achieving above NAPLAN NMS in Numeracy.
- Meet the target of 45% of Year 3 students achieving in NAPLAN Upper Two Bands for Reading and 35% for Numeracy.
- Meet the target of 80% of Prep students exiting at PM Reading Level 7 or above and writing short meaningful sentences
- Improve teacher pedagogical practices specifically in the areas of Explicit Instruction focused in Reading, Writing and Problem Solving

Our initiatives include


- Providing focused curriculum and pedagogical coaching for all teachers with dedicated specialised support from a Master Teacher, Beginning Teacher Mentor, coaches, classroom Teacher Mentors and Digital Technologies coach.
- Implementing a whole school approach to provide a continuum of literacy/numeracy support with personalised teaching and intervention that meets the needs of all students.
- Continuing to implement short, medium and long term goals in a 'cycle of review' that provides for analysis of data to ensure targeted, specific and immediate intervention strategies are implemented.

Build teacher capability in explicit teaching practices in literacy, problem solving and digital literacies through the Master Teacher, Teacher Mentors, Beginning Teacher Mentor, coaches and Digital Technologies Coach.	\$181,000
Employ teacher aides to assist classroom teachers in explicit teaching of literacy and expand current programs, providing Support-a-Talker and intervention for Prep-Year 2	\$52,793
Developing coaching capacity and improve Annual Performance Planning process for all staff	\$50,000
Provide Highly Capable Learning experiences for Years 2-6 in Writing and Reading	\$10,000
Release teachers 1 hour per week extra as Curriculum Coordination Time in year levels to build Professional Learning Communities with a focus on data interrogation, planning, moderation and Professional Development	\$146,000
Developing and monitoring each semester Individual Curriculum Plans for all eligible students and Individual Support Plans are in place for all students with a verified disability or who identify as Indigenous.	\$5,000
