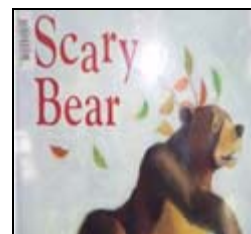

History

The Resource Centre was opened in 2000. Larger than the norm, it was designed for a P-10 school. Our former Library was opened in 1978 and is now the present Special Education Unit. The Library's collection is that combined from the former Humpybong Infants State School (Yrs 1,2) and Humpybong State School (Yrs 3-7) which

amalgamated in 1998.
